ADDITIONAL COURSE COSTS

Students should be aware that there may be other course costs in addition to course fees. Some of the potential costs you may need to consider are provided in the table below, but please note that this is not an exhaustive list.

<p>Accommodation & Living Costs We do not currently provide accommodation but can offer advice and support to source accommodation.</p>	Costs vary dependent on your choice of supplier.
<p>Student Card You will be given an HSU Student ID Card at no charge at the point of registration.</p>	£10.00 (non-refundable) is payable to replace a lost Student Card.
<p>Vaccinations Should you progress onto the M.Ost course all osteopathic students are also strongly advised to be immunised against Hepatitis B and to ensure that your immunisations against Polio, TB, Tetanus, MMR, Diphtheria and Varicella are up to date.</p>	Charged at NHS Prices
<p>Textbooks Our library is well stocked with all the textbooks you should need, but you may prefer to buy your own.</p>	Costs vary dependent on your choice of book and supplier.
<p>Computer / Laptop / Storage Devices We have desktop computers and printers for you to use at our campus, however you may wish to purchase your own computer / printer / storage devices at your own cost.</p>	Costs vary dependent on your choice of model and supplier.
<p>Travel to and from HSU You will need to pay for your own travel costs.</p>	Costs vary depending on the form of transport and the distance travelled.
<p>Printing / Photocopying You will need to pay for your own printing / photocopying costs which are currently £0.25 for colour, and £0.05 for black and white (all per printed sides).</p>	It is your choice to print or photocopy to support your studies.
