The review of procedures has removed the number of steps students have to go through.  Previously there were three complaint forms, and these have been replaced with one.	
NEW: Sexual Misconduct Policy and separate Sexual Misconduct Procedure  (formerly the Sexual Misconduct Policy and Procedure)	This policy has been reviewed and rewritten in line with the Office for Students Condition of Registration E6, which came into force on 1st August 2025.
